

- As Early as 1985 there were only seven Coptic families in Halifax.
- We had no church building at that time.
- Father Youssef Sedra used to come from Montreal and pray the Holly Mass in one of the congregation members' homes.



Saint Mena Coptic Orthodox Church 1985 (cont.)

- Later Father Elias and Father Maximos from Saint Antonios Antiochian Orthodox Church generously allowed us to use their church building on Saturdays.
 - Father Athanasius Iskandar from Ontario used to come every three months to pray a Coptic Holy Mass.




- In 1987, with more Coptic families settling in Halifax, an official Coptic community was founded (fewer than 10 families).
- Father Athanasius started to come once a month rather than every three months and they still used Saint Antonios Antiochian Orthodox Church.
- Following the Holy Liturgy the small Congregation gathered together for Aghape (they started the tradition we have today) at one of the congregation members' homes.

• Year after year the Congregation number grew with God's Blessing. There were more than 20 families by 1993.

By that time late Father Bishoy Saad from Montreal was also visiting regularly





- Families with young children started to come and settle in Halifax.
- The small Congregation with Father Bishoy's guidance started Sunday School classes on Saturdays following the liturgy.




Saint Mena Coptic Orthodox Church 1987 – 1997 (cont.)


- University students helped the older servants in the Sunday school tasks.


- In 2001 we celebrated the arrival of Father Daniel with his beautiful family, Tassoni Ekhlass, Irini, Keyro and Verena.




In 2018 we celebrated the arrival of Father Thomas with his beautiful family Tassoni Sahar, David and Nicole and they have been a true blessing for us.







- Along the years our church Youth has started activities that connected us, including but not limited to:
